

ASSIGN DOI AND URN

PLEASE NOTE: The Uniform Resource Name (URN) and the DOI are Persistent Identifiers (PID) that, unlike a URL, can be used to uniquely and consistently identifying online resources regardless of where they are stored. The URN ensures the long-term availability of online resources. The German National Library (<u>DNB</u>) manages and assigns the URN from the namespace "urn:nbn:de" and offers a URN Resolving Service for Germany and Switzerland.

The German National Library needs the URN to ensure long-term preservation of articles. The URN and the DOI can be generated automatically.

ASSIGN ISSUE

To generate the DOI and URN the affected article must be assigned to an issue.

$\textbf{Submissions} \rightarrow \textbf{All Active} \rightarrow \textbf{Select the article} \rightarrow \textbf{Publication} \rightarrow \textbf{Issue}$

You should then see the following stage:

ASSIGN DOI AND URN

To assign the DOI and URN, go to:

$\textbf{Submissions} \rightarrow \textbf{All Active} \rightarrow \textbf{Select the article} \rightarrow \textbf{Publication} \rightarrow \textbf{Identifier}$

You should then see the following:

By clicking on "Assign" next to the DOI and URN, the two identifiers are automatically assigned according to the selected scheme.

Then click on "Save" at the bottom of the page.
